One in might, and One in glory, while unending ages run.

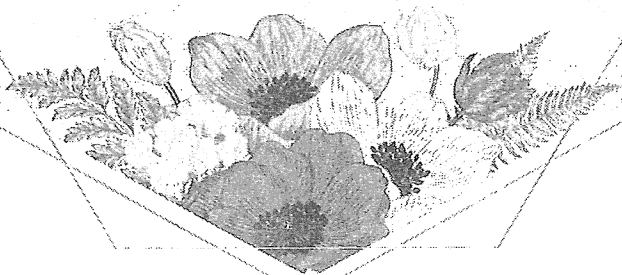
